WASHINGTON STATE IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS
 FOR
KINDERGARTEN ENTRY

(STATE OF WASHINGTON RCW 28A.210.160)

PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY!!

YOUR CHILD *MUST MEET THESE REQUIREMENTS IN ORDER TO ATTEND SCHOOL.

The Washington State Certificate of Immunization Status is required.

Your child's school must have a completed form showing that the following requirements have been met, or your child cannot be allowed to attend school.

DIPHTHERIA-TETANUS-PERTUSSIS	POLIO	MEASLES-MUMPS-RUBELLA	HEPATITIS B	VARICELLA (Chicken Pox)
<p>Your child must have at least 4 doses of DTP vaccine. Pertussis is required.</p> <p>There must be at least 6 months between the last 2 doses.</p> <p>The last DTP vaccine must be given on/after your child's fourth (4th) birthday.</p> <p>You must supply <u>type of vaccine</u> (DTP, DTaP, DT, Tdap or Td) and month, **day, and year of each vaccine.</p>	<p>Your child must have at least 4 doses of polio vaccine.</p> <p>3 doses of polio vaccine are acceptable only if the last dose is given on/after your child's fourth (4th) birthday.</p> <p>You must supply type of vaccine (OPV or IPV) and month, **day, and year of each vaccine.</p>	<p>Your child must have 2 doses of measles, mumps and rubella vaccine (MMR).</p> <p>Both MMR vaccines must be given on/after your child's first (1st) birthday.</p> <p>There must be at least 28 days between each dose of MMR vaccine.</p> <p>You must supply month, **day, and year of each MMR vaccine.</p>	<p>Your child must have 3 doses of hepatitis B vaccine.</p> <p>There must be at least one month between dose 1 and dose 2.</p> <p>Spacing for 3rd Hepatitis B Dose</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least 2 months after dose 2 • At least 4 months after dose 1 • At least 6 months of age <p>You must supply month, **day, and year of each vaccine.</p>	<p>Your child must have 2 doses of varicella vaccine.</p> <p>Both varicella vaccines must be given on/after your child's first (1st) birthday.</p> <p>There must be at least 28 days between each dose of varicella vaccine.</p> <p>Varicella must be received the same day as MMR <u>or</u> at least 28 days apart.</p> <p>You must supply month, **day, and year of the vaccine.</p>

**If no day is available, enter the first day of the month.

***Note:** Your child may be exempted (excused) from immunizations for medical, personal or religious reasons. However, if there is an outbreak of a vaccine-preventable disease that your child has not been immunized against, she or he can be excluded from school until the outbreak is over.
